It is important that BCA Insurance Services assess whether your policy meets the demands and needs of your current business activities. Over the last few years, chiropractors have expanded their role and undertake additional activities adjunct to their chiropractic care. The following covers many of the common areas that members notify the insurer of. There is also scope to notify items not in this table so that the insurer can establish whether cover can be extended.

The following activities are acceptable, subject to suitable training and qualifications, as appropriate and notification to your insurer. You should be able to demonstrate competence and expertise as per GCC Code G3. Activities must be administered as an adjunct and to compliment chiropractic treatment, and not in isolation.
